

## Financial transparency 2016/17

Our membership income comes from subscriptions and supplementary donations from members, associate members, affiliates and institutional subscribers. **In 2016/17 this amounted to £250,535.** As of 30th of June 2017, we had 7,295 members, affiliates and subscribers. No single member or organisational affiliate/subscriber donated more than £5,000 to our general funds. Income associated with specific research, editorial and events projects **totalled £480,920** in 2016/17 and came from a wide range of companies, trade unions, non-profit organisations and trusts.
