Financial transparency 2017/18

Our membership income comes from subscriptions and supplementary donations from members, associate members, affiliates and institutional subscribers. In 2017/18 this amounted to £277,803. As of 30th of June 2018, we had 7,202 members, affiliates and subscribers. No single member or organisational affiliate/subscriber donated more than £5,000 to our general funds. Income associated with specific research, editorial and events projects totalled £423,647 in 2017/18 and came from a wide range of companies, trade unions, non-profit organisations and trusts.
